Free health activities include Mammograms (to those who qualify, pre-registration required; appointments are still available), Blood Pressure Checks, Blood Sugar and Cholesterol Screenings (requires 12-hour fast, pre-registration required); Red Cross Blood Drive (appointments available and walk-ins welcome) diabetic foot screenings and many other health screenings will be available. The Area Agency on Aging will be available to answer questions and help Medicare participants enroll in a Medicare Part D Prescription Assistance program.
